

Public Service Pension History

There are protections that may apply to members when they transfer in pension rights or combine their existing Local Government pension rights. They apply when a member has not had a continuous break of more than five years in a Northern Ireland public service pension scheme. In order to identify if these protections apply to you, NILGOSC needs a history of any public service pension scheme membership that you may have. A public service pension scheme includes those providing pensions for civil servants, teachers, health service workers, fire and rescue workers, members of the police service and local government workers in Northern Ireland.
