As pension regulations have changed over the years, there will be differing criteria applied as to what could happen with your pension contributions when you left the Scheme. Please read this summary of the regulations and consider what action you would have taken given the options available to you.

- Until November 1973 manual workers normally had to complete a two-year waiting period before being eligible to join the pension Scheme. This waiting period was reduced to one year between November 1973 and May 1989. You would not have made contributions during the waiting period.
- If you were employed by any of the organisations listed below and left before the date they joined the Local Government Pension Scheme (NI), you need to contact the organisation directly as we do not hold any pension records or liability before these dates.
 - Belfast City Council (previously Belfast Corporation) joined the Scheme in October 1973.
 - NI Railways joined the Scheme in 1979
 - Citybus joined the Scheme in 1977.
 - Ulsterbus joined the Scheme in 1978.

- If you left the Scheme before 1975, you
 would have had two options regarding your
 superannuation contributions: a transfer to
 another pension scheme or a refund of your
 contributions. As Preserved Pension Benefits
 were not applicable before this date, these
 were the ONLY options available to if you left
 the Scheme before then.
- From 1975 to April 1988 Preserved Pension Benefits were introduced, however you needed a minimum of five years' service to qualify. If you left between this period and had less than five years' service, you could ONLY have a transfer to another pension scheme OR a refund of your contributions.
- Part-time employees were only permitted to join the Scheme from 1989.

 Transfer out to another pension scheme OR receive a refund of your contributions?
 If so, NILGOSC does not hold any liabilities for your pension.
