Consultation on NILGOSC's Vision, Mission, Values, Strategic Aims and Objectives

NILGOSC is currently carrying out a consultation on the draft statement of its Vision, Mission, Values, Strategic Aims and Objectives and would like to give you the opportunity to comment and help shape the service that we provide.

NILGOSC reviews these high-level elements of its strategic plan every three years and details of the strategic review process currently underway is set out in the attached summary document.
