1. **www.pruretire.co.uk is a user friendly website that gives you 24 hour access to details of your pension fund. A tried and tested website that is quick and simple to navigate around**
2. **A comprehensive website that enables you to:**
 - View the current value of your pension fund
 - Illustrate the pension that you could buy when you retire
 - Access information on fund prices and fund factsheets
 - See transactions on your account
3. **The website offers you the ability to:**
 - Review or change your investment choices at any time
 - Model different pension contributions and how different investment returns could impact your benefits
 - Change personal details
 - Where available, update and amend your contribution
4. **Within the website you can:**
 - Download useful and important literature
 - Access links to pension information websites
5. **Security is paramount; therefore the website can only be accessed using the unique username and password that you create.**

Please note that some functionality is not available to everyone and is dependant on agreement with your employer or the Trustee of the scheme.

Getting started

You need to register in order to benefit from this member website.

Please follow the steps below:

1. The first time you access **www.pruetire.co.uk** you need to create your own:

- Login name
- Password
- Security question and answer

2. Await receipt of your PIN (if you chose email or SMS text message this should be instantaneous upon completion of registration).
